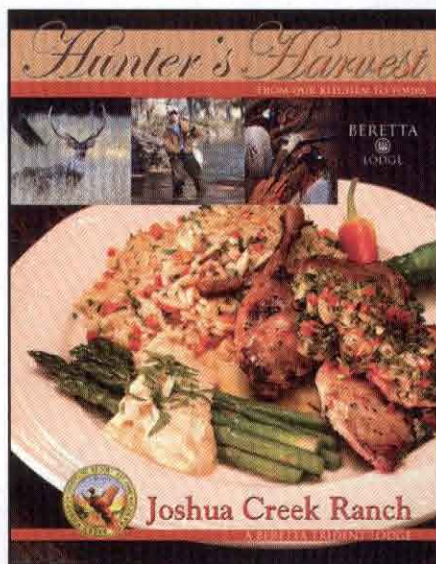

Joshua Creek Ranch Hunter's Harvest Cookbook

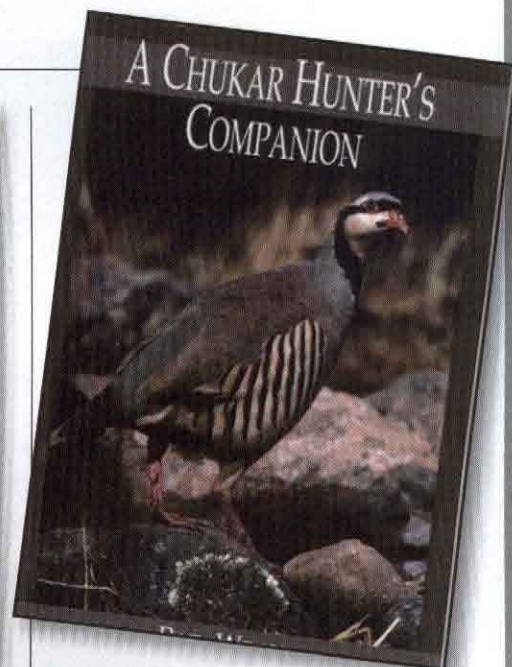
