

As a guest of JCR, you may bring your dog(s); however, it is required that you agree to and abide by the provisions outlined below in the JCR Pet Policy which was put into place for the safety of all JCR guests and their accompanying dogs as well the preservation of JCR property, facilities and lodging accommodations.

- 1. The only pets allowed at JCR are dogs.
- 2. Dog owners are required to provide current vaccination records from a licensed veterinarian for each dog brought to JCR.
- 3. Outdoor kennels accessible from all JCR lodging accommodations are available free of charge.
- 4. If you choose to keep your dog inside your JCR lodging accommodation, you will be charged a non-refundable fee of \$100 per stay plus \$25 per dog per night. If you fail to notify JCR Guest Services in advance that you are keeping a dog(s) inside JCR lodging accommodations, the non-refundable fees will increase to \$150 per stay plus \$50 per dog per night.
- 5. To keep a dog inside JCR lodging accommodations, dog owners must agree in writing to following rules and restrictions in advance of checking in to JCR lodging accommodations:
 - a. Dogs kept inside JCR lodging accommodations cannot weigh more than 40 pounds. If a dog is found to be more than 40 pounds, the dog must be kenneled or the owner will be asked to leave.
 - b. A maximum of 2 dogs per JCR lodging accommodation are allowed.
 - c. While in your JCR lodging accommodation, your dog must always be attended. If you are out, the dog(s) must be secured in a dog crate/carrier. If not, your daily fee will increase to \$50 per dog.
 - d. Unless your dogs are hunting, they must be on a leash whenever outdoors on JCR grounds. For its safety, your dog is never allowed to roam freely.
 - e. Dog owners are responsible for clean-up of feces, urine or any other debris left by dog inside JCR lodging accommodation, including dog hair.
 - f. As a courtesy to other guests, dog owners are responsible for immediately cleaning up and discarding feces left by your dog in common, high-traffic outdoor areas.
 - g. Dogs are not allowed inside the common areas at Cypress Lodge, Branch Haus Lodge, Long Haus, or Pool area.
 - h. Housekeeping will not enter the room to clean or perform refresh services unless the dog is out of the room or secured in a dog crate/carrier.
 - i. Please do not use bed linens, towels, rugs or the comforters as dog bedding.
 - j. Please do not use bath towels for the purpose of cleaning up after your dog.
 - k. Dogs are not allowed on any sofas, chairs, beds, rugs, tables or counter tops.
 - 1. If your dog disturbs other guests with excessive barking or aggressive behavior, you will be required to kennel the dog for the remainder of your stay.
 - m. Dog owner is responsible for any and all damages caused by their dog(s) as assessed by JCR housekeeping once guest has checked out of JCR lodging accommodation.
 - n. Dog owner is responsible for bites, scratches, or any other injuries or damage caused by their dog to any other JCR guest, staff member or other guests' dogs.
 - o. Dog owner is responsible for any injuries to their dogs no matter what the circumstances.
